At the heart of Reformed Theology is the belief that Israel rejected God's offer of salvation so God offered it to the church with the understanding that Israel will not get it back.





If God cast away Israel because of their lack of faith, who is to say that God will not do the same thing to the church and go with some other mysterious group of people?



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
#### Dispensational Theology


- While salvation has always remained through faith, God dealt differently with different people at different times.


#### General Revelation

Psalm 19:1 - The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.


### Special Revelation

Truths about God revealed in supernatural ways including physical appearances of God, dreams, visions, prophecy, and the written Word.




### Progressive Revelation

The Bible was written over a period of 1,600 years and covers over 4,000 years of history.



- Adam "I had no Bible at all, but I walked with God in the cool of the garden."
- Abraham "I had no Bible at all, but at different times God would appear to me and speak to me."
- Moses "My Bible contained 5 books—Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy."
- David "My Bible contained the same 5 books that Moses had as well as Joshua and Judges and many of the Psalms which I wrote."
- © Ezra "My Bible contained most of the Old Testament books but not all of them."

- John the Baptist "My Bible contained all of the Old Testament books but none of the New Testament books."
- Paul "My Bible contained the Old Testament books and most of the New Testament books but not all of them."
- Solution → "My Bible contained all of the Old Testament books and all of the New Testament books. Shortly before I died God used me to write the last New Testament book."



#### Stewardship of Conscience (Genesis 3:7 - 8:22)

- Man's State: Knowingly Naked
- Man's Responsibility: Pursue Holiness
- Man's Failure: Only one righteous family?

- God's Grace: No Water Destruction Again



#### Stewardship of Government (Genesis 8:23-11:32)

- Man's State: Sinful with a clean slate
- Man's Responsibility: Repopulation, Scattering, Animal Control, Death Penalty
- Man's Failure: Being Nimrods
- God's Judgment: The Tower of Babel
- God's Grace: Man is bent on destruction, but God is bent on loving him anyway.



#### Stewardship of Promise (Genesis 12:1 - Exodus 19:4)

- Man's State: A New Nation Abraham
- Man's Responsibility: Just Believe A Great Nation,
   Blessing, Protection, Savior, Land
- Man's Failure: Laughter, Favoritism, Supplanter, Rebellion
- God's Judgment: Egypt
- God's Grace: Moses



#### Stewardship of Law (Exodus 19:5 - Acts 1: 26)

- Man's State: A Theocracy
- Man's Responsibility: Obey Law
- Man's Failure: Complaining, Murmuring, Rebellion
- God's Judgment: Assyrian Captivity, Babylonian Captivity, Destruction of Jerusalem
- God's Grace: April 3, 33 A.D.



#### Stewardship of Grace (Acts 2 - Revelation 3)

- Man's State: Lost, Unrighteous, Not Good, Guilty,
   Sinner, Dead, Disobedient
- Man's Responsibility: Receive the Gospel & Live It
- Man's Failure: Rejection
- God's Judgment: Hell



## Literal Interpretation

Literal interpretation seeks to understand the Bible in its plain, natural, normal sense. It looks for the clear and obvious meaning of a text.

#### The Golden Rule of Interpretation

If the plain sense makes good sense seek no other sense lest it result in nonsense.

# Hippo eats dwarf

BANGKOK: A hippopotamus swallowed a circus dwarf in a "freak accident" in northern Thailand, according to a columnist in the Pattaya Mail.

The Grapevine column reported: "A circus dwarf, nicknamed Od, died recently when he bounced sideways from a trampoline and was swallowed by a yawning hippopotamus waiting to appear in the next act."

"Vets said Hilda the Hippo had a gag reflex which caused her to swallow. More than 1000 spectators continued to applaud wildly until they realised there had been a tragic mistake."

## The Kingdom of God

- Found 70 times in 60 verses in the New Testament.
- © Out of those 70 occurrences, 62 (85%) of them are in the Gospels and Acts.
- Paul mentions the concept only 8 times in his 21 epistles.

#### The Kingdom of Heaven

- Found 33 times in 32 verses in the New Testament.
- Every single occurrence is in the Gospel of Matthew.

#### The Kingdom of Heaven vs. God

- 12 parallel passages in Mark and Luke use KoG for Matthew's KoH.
- Matthew uses the terms interchangeably in Matthew 19:23-24.
- No author in Scripture argues for a distinction.
- Matthew uses "kingdom" without delineating which kingdom (KoG or KoH) he is referring to.

#### The Kingdom of Heaven vs. God

92% of the time, the concept of kingdom (KoG+KoH) occurs in the Gospels and Acts. If we remove Acts from the equation, kingdom occurs in the Gospels 85% of the time.

The Kingdom of God/Heaven is not a description of a spiritual relationship between Christ and his church, but rather a reference to the future Millennial Kingdom.

#### The Times of the Gentiles

The Times of the Gentiles is a period of time beginning with Babylon's conquering of the Temple Mount in 586 B.C. It will end with the overthrow of Gentile control of the Temple Mount when Jerusalem is freed from Gentile rule at Christ's Second Coming.

#### Psalm 132:11-12

The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne. If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore.

#### Psalm 132:13

For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired it for his habitation.



#### Salah 9:6-7
